Why do we want to do install enforceable weight limit signage?

HGVs and rat-running commercial traffic cause noise, damage to property and road surfaces and danger to other drivers, pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders.

The focus in Bethersden Parish will be on the **Unclassified Road Classification** that comprises – “*local roads intended for local traffic. The vast majority (60%) of roads in the UK fall within this category*”.

The construction of the New Town at Chilmington Green has commenced with an increase in HGVs and construction traffic. Enforceable Weight Restriction signage will protect our local lanes and village centre from rat-running HGVs and any other commercial traffic over 7.5 tons.

When will the Consultation start and how long will it take?

The Consultation period will last between 1 – 21st September 2018 and Parishioners are encouraged to post their comments about the scheme.
